SRDC and its partners focused on developing plans and seeking funding for upcoming segments of Schuylkill Banks in 2015. Thanks to these ongoing efforts, SRDC was able to bid out the South to Christian segment in 2015, and will be ready to bid the Bartram's Mile trail segment in early 2016. SRDC and the City have also secured all funding for the Schuylkill Crossing at Grays Ferry, and began plans for the Bartram's to Passyunk and Christian to Crescent segments, bringing us closer to our goal of a trail and greenway along the entire tidal Schuylkill.


Schuylkill Banks 2015 Trail & Greenway Statistics

The Schuylkill River Trail was named the Best Urban Trail in America by readers of USA Today and 10Best. This honor helped to increase awareness of this valuable riverfront amenity. SRDC continued to work with partners to host the annual Philly Fun Fishing Fest, the Walnut 2 Walnut regatta, and SRDC's regularly scheduled movie nights, kayak tours, and riverboat tours. Thousands of people came down to the Banks for a variety of programming and other riverfront recreation in 2015, continuing to activate the riverfront in Center City and Grays Ferry.


Schuylkill Banks 2015 Programming

SRDC is grateful to all of these volunteers, who helped with a wide variety of labor-intensive work, including picking up litter, mulching and spreading gravel, weeding and planting, painting, raking, and setting pavers.
